Those who serve in "background" roles in the liturgy can view their efforts as less important than the ministries of others who are visible. This can lead some to question whether what they do really matters.

It is to be hoped that planners never reach the depths of despair that Job expresses in todays' first reading. It is a passage that seems to have no hope — in fact, it says so explicitly: "My days ... come to an end without hope." Maybe Job would be diagnosed today with clinical depression. Certainly he was having a bad day, a whole series of bad days.

The liturgy responds to this depressing text with a psalm that reminds us that God has the power and will to heal the broken hearted. This is a good reminder to all of us to read the whole of the Liturgy of the Word to put each part of it in context.

St. Paul speaks today about the responsibility to preach the good news, whether he wants to or not. Planners, sacristans and other "behind the scenes" ministers are also involved in preaching the word of God. That word needs to be preached in every corner of the world, but it is also preached in church to those who seek to deepen their faith. Those who prepare for the liturgy, those who create schedules for ministers, those who clean the church and provide suitable décor for liturgy all contribute to the effective proclamation and preaching of the word.

We think of preachers as those who speak the word of God to the assembly. A quote attributed to St. Francis of Assisi calls us to "Preach the word always; when necessary, use words." St. Francis did preach by his life, but he also used words regularly.

In today's Gospel, it is Peter's mother-in-law who provides service for Jesus and his disciples, right after she is healed. We may not often consider how Jesus and his followers found food to eat and places to stay. The Gospels note that some women provided for them. Without that kind of help, their mission of preaching would have been significantly limited.

Whatever your contribution to the worship of your parish, remember that you are important for the continued preaching of the good news.

CANADA SUMMER JOBS PROGRAM

The federal government has introduced new requirements for employers applying for the Canada Summer Jobs grant. To be eligible for funding, employers must attest that both the job and the organization's core mandate respect certain "values" as determined by the federal government including the government's position on abortion, sexual orientation and gender identity or expression. Organizations unable or unwilling to make this attestation in whole or in part will be deemed ineligible for the grant. This requirement is clearly unjust.

An interfaith press conference was held on January 25th with representatives of Christian, Muslim and Jewish communities coming together to ask the government to amend the current application process, An interfaith statement, signed by 87 faith leaders from across Canada was released.

Cardinal Collins spoke directly with government minister for this program, asking that the requirements be modified to ensure faith-based organizations would not be placed in an untenable position.

Ongoing discussions between inter-faith coalition and government continues. Catholic organizations through the Archdiocese of Toronto and many other faiths involved in charitable activity are impacted by this decision.
