From the Pastor's desk,

This past year we completed few renovations and repairs in the church and washrooms through the Family of Faith Funds.



This year, we might have other challenges ahead of us. We might have other up-

coming projects and these may include the replacement of the heating and air conditioning units with more efficiency and energy savings. Do you know that we have a total of five HVAC units in our roof and this is the cause of high electrical bills. The life of the units are beyond life expectancy. The study is still undergoing at this time with the Chancery office and Morrison Hershfield Limited.

Another important upcoming project is the roof replacements: the Rectory, the annex, the Shrine, and a small repair from the choir cove in which the water builds up on the side because the water does not flow correctly to the drainage. These selected roofs were not included in the roof replacements done in the church and hall few years ago. Further investigation into the continued water leakage in the two bedrooms on the second floor have revealed that they are due to extensive cracks from the knee wall to the adjoining roof and the HVAC units and the roof was past its life expectancy. Three roofing companies have been contacted to tender their bids for this project.

Where are we going to get the money? Our parish currently has a capital funds deposit with the Archdiocese. While these funds remain the property of our parish, the Archdiocese loans them out to other parishes to assist them in the building and renovation of churches, while paying interest on the fund balance. These projects will be costly! These projects have been discussed with the members of the Parish Finance and the cost will be paid from our funds currently on deposit with the Archdiocese. I will keep you informed on the progress of these projects. For now, please continue to pray for us! God Bless.




