# HUMANITARIAN RELIEF - FLOOD-ING IN KERALA

In late July, the state of Kerala, India was devastated by severe flooding due to unusually high rainfall during the monsoon season. Roads have been wrecked and homes destroyed. To date, over 300 people have died, more than 1 million people displaced, living in relief camps, including more than 175,000 children under the age of 12.

In an effort to support the people in Kerala impacted by this disaster, the Archdiocese of Toronto is accepting funds that will be channeled through the Kerala Catholic Bishops' Council. Funds will be used to provide food, drinking water, clothes and medicine to people displaced. Funds will also be used for reconstruction of communities.
