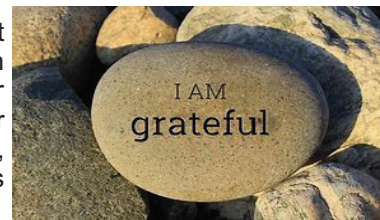

### From the Pastor’s desk...

#### **ROOF AND HVAC UNITS UPDATE!**

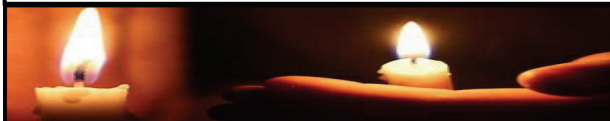
We are very pleased to announce that we are almost on the final phase of the projects: replacing the remaining roofs of our rectory, guest rooms and shrine, and replacing new three HVAC units. These HVAC units are located at the rectory rooftop, the guest quarters and above the boardroom and parish kitchen. The unit above the parish kitchen will be transferred to the rooftop to avoid further leaking in the parish kitchen and boardroom, and use the attic for storage. These three units caused leaks and caused damages on the ceilings and the different areas. These three HVAC units have exceeded the service life expectancy and this is a good time to replace them as we repair the roofs.

At this time, we are now seeking the permission and approval of the Chancery office to go ahead with the projects and the costs of how much we will be spending on to these projects.

The total projected cost of these projects is **\$117,298 + tax** which is also approved by the members of the parish Finance Council. This amount will be taken from our main account.

Once gain, I would like to thank you for your generosity to Prince of Peace Parish. These projects would not be possible without your help and generous contribution every week. God Bless!
