ROOF AND HVAC UNITS UPDATE!

We are very pleased to announce that we have received the final approval from the chancery office regarding the replacing of the remaining roofs of our rectory, guest rooms and shrine, and replacing new three HVAC units. We are now waiting for the contractors, The Semple Gooder Roofing Corporation and the HVAC Dimensions Mechanical Services, to set the date for the repairs to begin. We are hoping that they will begin as soon as possible before it gets colder.

The total projected cost of these projects is **\$117,298 + tax** which is also approved by the members of the Parish Finance Council. This amount will be taken from our main account.

Once again, I would like to thank you for your generosity to Prince of Peace Parish . These projects would not be possible without your help and generous contribution every week. God Bless!

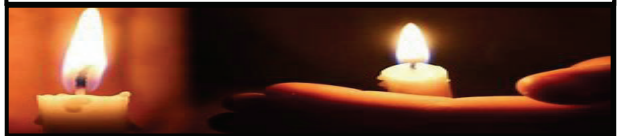
