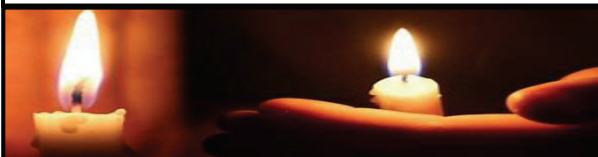
Jesus shows us that God's way is the way of love. Throughout the gospels,

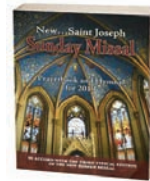
