SOLEMNITY OF ST. MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL



Cardinal Collins has announced that the Feast of St. Michael the Archangel will be observed as a Solemnity on the weekend of September 28 & 29, 2019, replacing the 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time in all parishes and missions in the Archdiocese of Toronto. The prayers and readings at Mass will not be those printed in your Sunday missal, but will be specific to the Feast of the Archangels – Michael, Gabriel and Raphael.

The Cathedral-Basilica bears St. Michael’s name, and St. Michael is considered the Patron Saint of our Archdiocese.

Federal Election Debate From A Catholic Perspective

Thursday, October 3, 2019 – 7:30 p.m.

The next federal election will be held on October 21, 2019. To help educate Catholic voters, the Archdiocese of Toronto has organized a debate from a Catholic perspective on Thursday, October 3, with candidates from the four major political parties, which will be moderated by veteran political journalist, Don Newman. Cardinal Collins will begin and end the evening with a personal reflection and prayer. This free ticketed event will take place at the John Bassett Theatre at the Metro Toronto Convention Centre with an audience of 1000 guests.

Due to an overwhelming response to this debate, tickets at the John Bassett Theatre are now sold out, and a waiting list has been created. Therefore, four archdiocesan parishes (located in Brampton, North York, Barrie and Oshawa) equipped with the appropriate technology, are opening their halls for viewing parties to bring interested Catholics together to participate in this important evening. In Durham Region, the designated viewing location is St. Joseph the Worker Parish, 1100 Mary Street North, in Oshawa (phone: 905 432-2300).

The Archdiocese will be communicating with those who have already obtained a ticket for the John Bassett Theatre should they wish to attend a more convenient location. Their tickets will then be offered to those on the waiting list. Individuals can also livestream the event from their own home should they wish to do so.
