## AUSTRALIA FIRES

As you are aware, in recent weeks, hundreds of forest fires in Australia have killed dozens, destroyed thousands of homes and threatened many local species with extinction. More than 10 million hectares of bush, forest and parks in the country have been impacted.

Locally the St. Vincent de Paul Society, has volunteers on the ground in hundreds of communities across the country helping people as they deal with the immediate aftermath of fires as well as long term recovery.
