Today's Gospel, *Matthew 13:1-23*, tells the parable of a sower who scatters seeds on different kinds of ground. As the seeds are sown, some fall and get lost on the path, some lack roots and wither in the sun, and some are planted near thorns and choked; however, the ones that fall on good soil produce a rich harvest. Here, Jesus is reminding us that we are the ground and the seeds are God's Word. Sometimes our hearts are hard because of anger or pride. Sometimes they are crowded with worries, leaving little room for God. But when we pray, trust in the Lord, and choose to live with love and kindness, our hearts become good soil. Only then can the seeds of God's Word take deep root, grow strong, and bear fruit in our lives.
