

Year of St. Joseph




Pope Francis announced 2021 as a Year of St. Joseph in honor of the 150th anniversary of the saint's proclamation as patron of the universal Church. The year begins Dec. 8, 2020, and concludes on Dec. 8, 2021, according to a decree authorized by the pope. The decree said that Pope Francis had established a Year of St. Joseph so that "every member of the faithful, following his example, may strengthen their life of faith daily in the complete fulfillment of God's will." It added that the pope had granted special indulgences to mark the year. The three conditions for receiving a plenary indulgence are sacramental confession, the reception of

Holy Communion and prayer for the pope's intentions.
