REOPENING OF PRINCE OF PEACE CHURCH WITH 15% CAPACITY

The provincial government announced changes to restrictions on places of worship in Grey (Lockdown) Zone. As of Monday, March 15th, 2021, churches in this designation (in the archdiocese, currently Toronto and Peel Regions) were permitted at 15 per cent capacity (our church capacity is 100 people).

Prince of Peace will open for Eucharistic celebration starting Monday, March 15th. You must register each week through our website for all weekday and Sunday Masses. Phone calls for registration to the parish office will not be accepted. Please arrive at the church 15 minutes ahead of your scheduled mass.

Prior to coming to church, please do a self-assessment as per COVID-19 regulations from public health. Upon entering the church please note:

- Sanitize upon entering
- Wearing face mask is mandatory
- Kindly drop off your church donation before entering or upon exiting the main body of the church
- Follow the instructions of the ushers as you enter, exit and while in the church. Due to COVID restrictions, ushers will seat you inside the church. Please maintain that seating and do not make any changes.
- Upon exiting, there should be no congregating in the church lobby, outside of the main entrance and in the parking lot.
