THE THREE PILLARS OF LENT

In the season of lent, the church provides us with three disciplines to help us grow in the spiritual life. These "pillars" of lent are Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. Jesus teaches us that to give alms, means to make the needs of others our own. We are especially called to pro-



vide for the most vulnerable people in our world: children and the old, the sick and the suffering, families and individuals, next-door neighbors and people in lands faraway. Whatever we give should be something of ourselves, something that costs us. We follow in the example of Christ who gave his life for us that we might live. This is why fasting and almsgiving go together. We fast to recognize our privilege. We fast to recognize the suffering of our brothers and sisters who have less than us and we fast to remind ourselves of our hunger for God. As we fast, we hope to nurture a spirit of gratitude and a spirit of generosity. However, we cannot do any of this without strengthening our relationship with God in prayer which grounds us and strengthens us. This Lent, we invite the parish community to join in the practice of these pillars of Lent.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

On Fridays during Lent, we gather in the church at **7pm** to pray the Stations of the Cross. On first Fridays we will pray the Stations of the Cross after



the **7pm** Mass. Confessions will be available at **6:30pm** to **7:30pm** every Friday during Lent.

RECONCILIATION TREE



The real work of conversion happens when we concretely address the areas in our lives

where we are most in need of mercy and reconciliation. This year, as a parish community, we have set up a

Reconciliation Tree in the sanctuary of the Church. Each week, we will focus on an area of our lives in which we are in need of healing and reconciliation. You are encouraged to attach a ribbon onto the tree to indicate each instance of such mercy that you experience throughout the week. This can be times when you have been the object of mercy or when you have been merciful to others. At the end of lent, when the tree is completely covered in ribbons, we can rejoice knowing that we have experienced God's compassionate, forgiving love in our lives and brought that same healing love to others.












FIRST COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION PROGRAMS
