
STATIONS OF THE CROSS

STEWARDSHIP ASCENDING AND DESCENDING THE MOUNTAIN


Just as the apostles were invited to ascend the mountain for the Lord's trans-



◆ LECTORS & RESPONSE LEADERS: A meeting will be held on Thursday, March 17 at 7pm in the Church.



◆ **CANTORS**: A meeting for existing and new cantors will be held on Wednesday, March 16 at 7pm in the Church (choir area). Confirm your attendance at: fr.efren@princeofpeacesc.ca



- ♦ MINISTERS OF HOSPITALITY (USHERS): a meeting for those who are able to attend will be held on Tuesday, March 22 at 7pm in the Parish Hall.
- ◆ SACRISTANS: This volunteer position is currently under evaluation due to its level of risk and the fact that duties of several independent ministries have been added to this role over time. In the unlikely event that this ministry is needed, it will be reinstated under the norms of Volunteer Screening as established by Archdiocesan norms. For now, anyone who had this position pre-covid, is invited to volunteer for the role of either the Adult Altar Server or the Extraordinary Minister of Communion.

If you cannot attend the meeting assigned to your ministry, we will have more meetings later on so that everyone has a chance to participate.

THE THREE PILLARS OF LENT

In the season of lent, the church provides us with three disciplines to help us grow in the spiritual life. These "pillars" of lent are Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. Jesus teaches us that to give alms, means to make the needs of others our own. We PRAY FAST GIVE are especially called to provide for the most vulnerable people in our world: children and the old, the sick and the suffering, families and individuals, next-door neighbors and people in lands faraway. Whatever we give should be something of ourselves, something that costs us. We follow in the example of Christ who gave his life for us that we might live. This is why fasting and almsgiving go together. We fast to recognize our privilege. We fast to recognize the suffering of our brothers and sisters who have less than us and we fast to remind ourselves of our hunger for God. As we fast, we hope to nurture a spirit of gratitude and a spirit of generosity. However, we cannot do any of this without strengthening our relationship with God in prayer which grounds us and strengthens us. This Lent, we invite the parish community to join in the practice of these pillars of Lent.
