





LITURGICAL VOLUNTERS

We are currently reorganizing our return to Church and we have had some meetings to discuss the steps we will take to return to these ministries. As we gradually implement these ministries, we will continue to have gatherings to include those who could not attend. Also, we will be inviting parishioners who wish to join these ministries so that they receive the necessary formation to be fit for service in the parish. The following are some of the results we agreed upon so far:

SACRISTANS: we continue to invite them to join one of the ministries currently needed. Presently, we are reassessing and restructuring this position to be in alignment with the norms of Volunteer Screening. We recognize the service that they provided over the years to the community and we thank them for serving the parish in this capacity.

LECTORS & RESPONSE LEADERS: As



agreed during the meeting, the use of face coverings is optional while proclaiming the Word of

God but on while in the congregation before and after the readings are proclaimed. We also continue to remind Lectors that regular Sunday Mass attendance at Prince of Peace is a requirement. Response leaders will, in time, undergo some changes as the needs of those at home change.

ALTAR SERVERS (YOUTH): existing altar



servers are now being prepared to return. Also, we are currently welcoming children who wish to

become altar servers to contact Fr. Martin to enroll and begin training. The following are training session dates for existing altar servers only:

> Saturday, April 2nd (training for Holy Week)

CANTORS: will begin by joining in the choir area to assist and gradually take over some of the parts of the mass from Fr. Efren. This will take time to adjust so each cantor will go at his/her own pace.

MINISTERS OF HOSPITALITY (USHERS): This group will meet on Tuesday, March 22 at 7pm in the Parish Hall. We will discuss Covid restrictions that will be dropped starting Monday. March 21 as well as other related matters.
