


SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION



On March 13, 2020 Cardinal Collins issued a communication indicating the necessity to cancel public celebrations of the Eucharist and granting the faithful dispensation from their Sunday obligation. Since most of the health and safety restrictions in our parish-

es are no longer in place and the faithful are able to attend the Celebration of the Eucharist once again, the basis for the dispensation from the Sunday obligation has dissipated and is no longer in effect. The church does not obligate people to do the impossible. If individuals cannot attend Mass for a grave reason, due to vulnerability to COVID-19 or because they are selfisolating, then they are excused from their Sunday obligation. As we celebrate Pentecost this weekend, we invite and encourage the faithful to return to the practice of attending Mass in person.
