6:30pm in the parish hall. It is important for all ushers, regardless of what tasks they perform, to attend this meeting.


NEEDS OF THE CANADIAN CHURCH

BLESSING OF PETS (St. Francis Feast) Tuesday, October 4, 2022




Many people bring their pets to the church to be blessed on St. Francis' feast day because of his love for animals as expressed in his Canticle of Creatures. This year, at the


