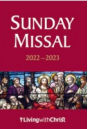

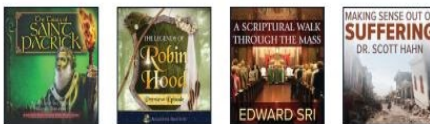

During these three masses, a collection will be taken and it is then that All Souls envelopes will be collected as an offering for our beloved departed. If you cannot attend any of these masses, you can submit your offering during the offertory any Sunday in November. Please note that the names you write on the envelopes will be for the Mass only, not the slides, which will be conducted differently to give equal opportunity to everyone.
