For the entire month of November, the Book of Life will be present in the sanctuary for everyone to add the names of their deceased family members and friends.

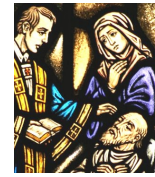


## KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS
