As we begin our Lenten journey, it is important to once again apply the lessons of Jesus' time in the desert to our entire lives. Jesus not only endured temptation, He confronted it. He was not afraid of the devil and did not fear his attacks. He willingly faced those temptations, being led by the Spirit, so as to not only overcome them in His life but also to enable us to confront, in our lives. We must never be afraid to confront temptations directly and confidently when the Holy Spirit is in the lead.

RECONCILIATION TREE

The real work of conversion happens when we concretely address the areas in our lives where we are most in



need of mercy and reconciliation. This year, as a parish community, we will set up a Reconciliation Tree in the sanctuary of the Church. Each week, we will focus on an area of our lives in which we are in need of healing and reconciliation. You are encouraged to attach a ribbon onto the tree to indicate each instance of such mercy that vou experience throughout the week. This can be times when you have been the object of mercy or when you have been merciful to others. At the end of lent, when the tree is completely covered in ribbons, we can rejoice knowing that we have experienced God's compassionate, forgiving love in our lives and brought that same healing love to others.

ARCHBISHOP OF TORONTO



Pope Francis has appointed Bishop Francis (Frank) Leo, as the 14th Archbishop of Toronto. The archbishopdesignate succeeds Cardinal Thomas Collins, who has served the archdiocese since 2007. The new archbishop will be installed at a ceremony at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica on Saturday, March 25, 2023, at 10am. Due to space restrictions, we anticipate this will be an invitation-only event. During this time

Stations of the Cross after the **7pm** mass. Each group will use a different version of the Stations of the Cross to help us appreciate the beauty



of the many that have been written over the years. This practice allows us all to participate in as much as we are able to. You can choose to participate in all or in part. We hope this helps you enter into the holy season of Lent.
