During the Fridays of Lent you are encouraged to give up vour dinner

budget and donate it to the poor. In turn, you and your family are invited to join us for soup and bread from 5pm to 6pm in the Parish Hall. An alms-giving box will be set out to receive donations that will be used to

feed the poor in our community. After the meal, we will have our Lenten Spiritual Exercises based on the Lenten Series *Eternal Rest* which include a 30 minute episode from FORMED and group reflection afterwards (6pm-7pm). Then we move to pray the Stations of the Cross at 7pm in the church led by one of the parish groups. You can choose to participate in all or in part. We hope this helps you enter into the holy season of Lent.

RECONCILIATION TREE

This Lent, every time vou reconcile with someone you are encouraged to attach a ribbon onto the tree

standing in the sanctuary of the Church. Would it not be a great sign for us to see this tree covered completely in white by the end of these forty days? Encourage your children to be proud when they learn what forgiveness can do in their lives. We can begin by giving them an example by doing it ourselves.

EASTER FLOWERS

Every year we are given the opportunity to express our gratitude or to remember someone in a special way by decorating the



sanctuary for Easter. Donations may be made "In Memory of Loved Ones" or "In Thanksgiving" and the names will be published on the slides in the church during the week for the duration of the Season of Easter.
