THE PASSPORT OFFICE



Passports have been "issued" to all the children preparing for sacraments as they make the "journey" to the celebration of the sacrament. The

ALL SOULS MASSES



The Church has always taught us to pray for those who have gone into eternity. Therefore, once again, we invite the community to join in our practice to

remember the Faithful departed by attending mass on **November 2** at **8:30am or 7:00pm.** A collection of All Souls Envelope intentions will be taken at this mass.

BOOK OF LIFE

This practice is known to all of us. However, in order to have a meaningful experience here at our parish, we need to avoid the tendency



to write names outside your own immediate family (parents, grandparents, spouses, children). This will give us the opportunity to see the names on the slides during mass. But if we all submit pages of names, then it becomes impossible to have a meaningful experience where we all get a chance to see the names of those closest to us. In the past we have received pages with sometimes up to 50 names. If we were to put them in the slides we would only see their names. We cannot post them all so we are going to ask that everyone limits themselves to no more than 3 names. If you submit more, then the names will be listed on the screen under the family name.

ALL SOULS ENVELOPES



These are now available in the office and will also be available in the church

before and after all masses and during the week. The names submitted on the envelope will be your private intention included in the general intentions for All Souls in Purgatory at both masses on **November 2 (8:30am & 7pm)**. During these masses, a collection will be taken and it is then that All Souls envelopes will be collected as an offering for our beloved departed. If you cannot attend any of these masses, you can place your envelopes in the collection basket any Sunday in November.
