Throughout Judeo-Christian history, people have explored how to live as God's people. Reflecting on our bottom line as committed Christians could not be more relevant in our current political and economic climate. ## **BOOK OF LIFE & SLIDES**

sheets provided on the table in the sanctuary. We ask that you fill in the sheet specifically for the 'Book of Life' where the names you write down will be entered into the 'Book of Life' by members of the office staff. These names will not appear on the slides.

**Slides:** Parishioners who would like to see the names of their dearly departed on the Slides during the mass are asked to write down, on the sheets in the Sanctuary (sheets that include the weekend mass times), no more than 3 names, along with the specific mass you attend (5pm, 8:30am, 10am 11:30am 1pm).

These names will appear on the slides for the entire month of November and only during the mass you select. Be sure to include the time of the mass you plan on attending so that you will see the name. By limiting everyone to only 3 names, will give us the opportunity to see these names on the slides during mass. In the past we have received pages with sometimes up to 50 names. If we were to put all the names on the slides chances are, we would never see them all. Thank you for your cooperation.
