Each week parishioners may request special prayer intentions to be added to the light of the candle and brought to our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.




Pro Populo

of the parish who in the past have set up an altar to participate with us this year. Details will be announced closer to the date.


A WORD OF THANKS AND CONGRATULATIONS TO FR. MARTIN




