#### **EXCITING NEWS ABOUT CHURCH ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENTS!**

As part of our Family of Faith campaign, we've been committed to making our church more accessible for everyone. We're thrilled to announce that starting **Monday**, **October 7**, we will begin important work to improve accessibility and safety around our parish. Here's what you can expect:



- Widening the sidewalk on the side of the church to allow better access for wheelchairs and other mobility devices.
- Expanding the driveway at the front slightly to accommodate the new, wider side-
- ◆ Replacing cracked or broken walkways with new concrete for smoother, safer walking paths.
- Repaying the entire parking lot for a fresh and safe surface.
- Once the paving is complete, we will repaint the parking lot lines and add more barrier-free parking spaces next to the current ones at the back.

#### HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- ◆ <u>From Monday, October 7 to Friday, October 11,</u> the parking lot will remain accessible for weekday Masses, with the help of the contractor to guide you safely in and out of the parking lot.
- For the weekend Masses of October 12 and 13, the parking lot will be open as usual.
- From Tuesday, October 15 to Friday, October 19, the parking lot will be closed for paving. We kindly ask you to park on the west side of the street during this time. If you're able, consider walking or cycling to Mass! Please avoid parking at the school, as they need their spots for staff and visitors.

All of this work is weather-dependent, but the contractor is committed to finishing as quickly as possible. We're grateful for your patience and understanding as we complete these much-needed improvements. Lastly, the City has notified us that they will begin some curb and sidewalk reconstruction, along with repaving the roadway in front of the parish, starting the week of **October 21.** We'll keep you updated on that project as we learn more. Thank you for your continued support as we work together to make our parish a more accessible and welcoming place for all!
