## **PARKING RULES**



At Prince of Peace, we are observing increasing disregard for parking rules, which are essential for safe and orderly operations. We kindly ask all

parishioners to follow these guidelines:

- 1. Reserved Parking: Spots priests, staff, organists, and key volunteers must remain accessible for those on duty. Even if empty, these spaces are not available for general use, as staff may return at any time.
- 2. Assigned parking for persons with disabilities: Only those with a permit may use these spaces, and they should wait until the prior Mass attendees have vacated before parking. These spots are also "No standing" zones.
- 3. Non-Parish Visitors: Our lot is strictly for parish use. Unauthorized parking by visitors to nearby locations may lead to enforcement measures, including fines.
- 4. Alternative Parking: If the lot is full, overflow parking may be available at Goldhawk parking lots (not the library) and at the school. Be sure to observe rules as well to avoid being ticketed.

We appreciate everyone's co-operation in keeping our parish respectful and safe.
