CHRISTMAS TOY DRIVE


A Christmas tree at the church entrance is decorated with gift tags for children who might otherwise go without a gift this Christmas. To contribute, select a tag and return your

TRIDUUM IN HONOUR TO OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE


