MEDICAL EMERGENCIES AT MASS

During the Holy Thursday liturgy, a medical emergency occurred among the congregation. We are deeply grateful to our parishioners who responded with calm, prayer, and respectful silence. Your trust in the response was a sign of the unity and maturity of our community. As context: a trained medical professional was nearby and responded immediately to the individual in distress. This was recognized by the pastor, who then made the pastoral decision to continue the liturgy, knowing that the situation was being handled appropriately and with care. Please remember that when emergencies arise, we follow clear safety and pastoral protocols that state that trained ushers and medical personnel respond discreetly while clergy discern whether to pause or proceed. In most cases, quiet continuity protects the person's privacy, allows for swift access, and avoids unnecessary distress. Unless vou are a trained medical professional, please do not approach. Remain seated, stay calm, and pray silently. Discretion is not indifference. It is compassion expressed with dignity. Thank you for helping us keep our worship space safe, reverent, and respectful for all.


