#### A SEASON OF PASTORAL TRANSITION: THE GRACE TO BEGIN AGAIN



Pro Populo

This Sunday, Jesus tells the parable of two men who went up to the temple to pray—one a Pharisee, confident in his own goodness, and the other a tax collector, painfully aware of his need for mercy. The first stands tall, listing his virtues. The second bows low, whispering only, "God, be merciful to me, a sinner." Jesus says that it was the humble man who went home justified. In this simple story, we find a truth for every season of faith, and especially for a parish in transition. The proud heart clings to control, but the humble heart learns to trust. The Pharisee measures success by achievement; the tax collector


measures it by grace. As we continue to walk through this season of change, the Lord invites us to pray as the humble one prayed—to begin again with open hands and an open heart. The coming months will stretch us to rely not on habit, but on hope. It is easy to look backward or to compare one chapter with another, but God calls us forward—to believe that His mercy can do something new. The Church is not held together by certainty, but by surrender. Grace is what built this parish; grace will carry it into its next chapter. Like the tax collector, we come before God aware of our weakness, but also confident in His compassion. Every act of faith, every quiet prayer, every moment of trust becomes a way of saying, "Lord, teach us to walk humbly with You." "Those who humble themselves will be exalted." — Luke 18:14. (Fr. #### **OFFERTORY ENVELOPES**




Remember Your Offertory envelopes 2026 will be ready for pick up in the Parish Hall begin-

If you are presently donating by Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG) or Credit Card (CC) and no longer want to use a full box of envelopes, please call the office for options. Parishioners who would like to use PAG or Credit Card donating methods can register using the forms available at each station. If you need assistance with this, please call the office. We ask that you do not use envelopes from previous years as those numbers might have been reassigned to someone else, and do not use the 2026 envelopes until January 2026. If you would like to donate and do not have an assigned envelope number, any regular envelope can be used as long as you indicate your name and full address or visit the parish office where you will be assigned a box of offertory envelopes.

When we think of the missions in the church, we often think about those striving to spread the


