A SEASON OF PASTORAL TRANSITION: THE TEMPLE AND THE TURNING




oro Populo

This weekend, we celebrate the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica – the mother church of Rome and a symbol of the Church's enduring presence. In the Gospel, Jesus enters the temple and finds it desecrated. He does not remain silent. He overturns the tables, drives out the merchants, and declares: "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." It is a moment of fierce mercy. A moment when the sacred is defended, and the false is cast out. This Gospel speaks to us now. Our parish is not being destroyed, but it is being disrupted. We are in a season of turning—letting go of what was, preparing for what

will be. And in that turning, we feel the tremble. We feel the vulnerability. We feel the ache of change. But Jesus does not fear the tremble. He walks into it. He clears what must be cleared. And He promises resurrection. As we prepare to welcome our new pastor, Fr. Damian Young-Sam-You, we do so with reverence. He comes to us with a heart shaped by service - a certified mechanic who knows how to rebuild what's broken, a chaplain to the police who walks with courage into places of pain, a self-taught DJ who has turned music into ministry, and a former vocation director who has helped others discern the voice of God. He comes not to replace, but to renew. Not to perform, but to serve. This time calls for prayerful listening, gentle courage, and unity of heart. It also calls for vigilance-against the noise that often follows change: the comparisons, the rumors, the temptation to stir division. These are not the voice of the Spirit. They are the merchants in the temple. Let us be bold enough to clear them. Let us be faithful enough to trust the One who rebuilds. And let us be humble enough to walk together - not in fear, but in hope. "The temple of God, which you are, is holy." - 1 Corinthians 3:17


