A SEASON OF PASTORAL TRANSITION: THE CROWN AND THE CROSS



Pro Populo

This weekend, we proclaim Christ as King—not a ruler of empires, but a shepherd of souls. His throne is not gilded, but wooden. His crown is not jeweled, but thorned. And yet, He reigns. Not by force, but by love. This Gospel speaks to us now. Our parish is not a kingdom in crisis, but a people in passage. We are in a season of surrender—laying down our need for control, and lifting up our trust in the One who reigns through mercy. And in that surrender, we feel the ache. The ache of letting go. The ache of endings. The ache of remembering. November is the month of the dead, and Christ the King is the

final feast of the liturgical year. It is a time when the veil thins, and we feel the weight of what has passed—loved ones, seasons, chapters, and roles. Yet even here, Christ reigns. He does not rule from a distance. He rules from the Cross. He reigns from the place of our pain. But every cross invites a test. In every season of change, there are those who circle close to the crown—longing for the gold but avoiding the thorns. They speak loudly of renewal but quietly seek control. The true disciple, however, learns that there is no crown without the Cross, and no leadership without sacrifice. This time calls for humble allegiance—to Christ first, and always. It calls for spiritual courage—to follow a King who kneels to wash feet. And it calls for communal fidelity—to walk together, not as subjects, but as siblings. Let us be bold enough to crown Him with our trust. Let us be faithful enough to follow where He leads. And let us be strong enough to carry one another through the ache of transition. "Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise." — Luke 23:43
