"Wake Up, Something New Is Beginning"

This Sunday Jesus invites us to "stay awake," not with fear, but with faith. Advent always begins in the dark, because God often arrives quietly, before our eyes adjust. Like the generations before Noah, it is easy to fall asleep to the deeper movements of grace, to become absorbed in the routines of life and unaware of how God is drawing near. Advent is the season that teaches us to notice again. As our parish begins this new liturgical year, we do so in a moment of transi-



tion, a moment when wakefulness is more important than ever. Change has a way of stirring what we would rather keep settled. It exposes our longings, our hopes, and even our anxieties. Yet Jesus does not say, "Be afraid." He says, "Be ready." He asks us to live with an open heart, to resist the temptation to numbness or distraction, and to trust that every ending contains the promise of a beginning. Over the past months, our community has carried many emotions: gratitude, sadness, uncertainty, and hope. Advent gathers all of these into the hands of God. This season does not ask us to pretend that everything is easy. It asks us to stay awake to what God is doing beneath the surface. Some doors are closing. Some chapters are shifting. Yet the Lord walks toward us with gentle steps, offering light strong enough to guide the way. Let this Advent be a time of holy attentiveness. Let us wake up to grace, to one another, and to the God who comes quietly, faithfully, lovingly. The One who arrives is Emmanuel—God with us—especially in the in-between places where we wait, wonder, and walk forward together. *Mt* 24:37–44
