A SEASON OF PASTORAL TRANSITION: "THE COURAGE TO WALK A NEW PATH"



John the Baptist appears in the desert with a startling message: "Prepare the way of the Lord." The desert is a place of truth, where there is nothing to hide behind. In that stark landscape, God speaks clearly. John calls the people not to fear, but to movement-to leave behind whatever keeps them stuck, resentful, or divided, and to walk into the future with repentant, renewed hearts. As our parish continues through this season of transition, this call becomes very real. Change can feel like a desert: spacious, uncertain, and honest. It reveals both the stories we cling to and the ones we must release. It exposes the voices around us-some helpful, some distracting, some ma-

nipulative, some wise. Advent invites us to listen for the only voice that matters: the voice that leads toward Christ. To "prepare the way" does not mean to fix everything. It means to clear the space where grace can work. It means letting go of old expectations, forgiving past hurts, and allowing God to reshape what lies ahead. It means trusting that even when the path bends, God walks with us. This week, John the Baptist points not to himself, but to the One who is coming. In the same way, this community is learning to look beyond personalities and circumstances and to fix our eyes on the Lord who never leaves us. There is Someone greater already on the horizon, Someone who holds this parish, its past, its present, and its future. Let us walk together with courage. Let us choose the path of peace, humility, and readiness. And let us believe that God is preparing something new, even in the wilderness. *Matthew 3:1–12*




Our Parish will be holding the Advent Days of Confessions from December 15-19 from 9am-10am (after the 8:30am mass).
