A SEASON OF PASTORAL TRANSITION: GAUDETE - JOY THAT GROWS IN WAITING



Pro Populo

Gaudete Sunday invites us to rejoice. Yet the joy of this day is not loud or forced. It is the quiet joy that grows in the soil of waiting. John the Baptist, now imprisoned, sends messengers to Jesus with a painful question: "Are you the One who is to come?" Even the greatest prophet experiences moments of uncertainty and longing. Jesus responds gently, pointing not to theories, but to signs: the blind see, the lame walk, the poor receive good news. Joy comes not from having every answer but from recognizing God's presence in the unfolding. Our parish understands this kind of joy. We do not deny the ache of transition nor the grief of change.

Yet in the midst of that ache, God has been quietly faithful. New ministries have grown, relationships have deepened, prayers have strengthened, and hope has taken root. The joy of Gaudete is not an escape from reality but a proclamation that God is at work in reality. This Sunday invites us to rejoice in small things: the unity we choose, the patience we practice, the compassion we show, the trust we nurture. These are the signs that Christ is already among us. As we move toward Christmas and toward the arrival of new pastoral leadership, we are reminded that joy is not something we wait to feel. It is something we practice. It is a posture of the heart that says, "God is here, even now." Let this be our joy that the Lord is faithful, that the future is held in His hands, and that together we will walk into the next chapter with grace. *Matthew* 11:2–11
