CHRISTMAS IS A SEASON OF CHANGE: A HOME BUILT ON TRUST

The Holy Family did not live a peaceful or predictable life. They fled danger, navigated uncertainty, and followed God's guidance step by step. Their home was not defined by stability, but by trust. What held them together was not perfect circumstance but faithful surrender to God's will. This feast speaks gently and honestly to our parish reality. A parish, like a family, is made up of different personalities, stories, hopes, and wounds. It grows through moments of joy and moments of upheaval. What matters most is not that everything remains the same, but that God remains at the center.

As we celebrate Christmas and stand on the threshold of a new year, this Gospel invites us to reflect on how we walk together as a community. We are living through a season of pastoral transition, and like the Holy Family, we do not see the entire path ahead. Yet they trusted the light they were given for the next step, and that was enough. Their courage was quiet. Their faith was steady. Their hope was rooted in God. The Holy Family offers us a model for this moment: protect what is holy, let go of what is harmful, and trust God for what comes next. In times of change, the call is not to fear, but to fidelity. Not to cling, but to accompany one another with patience and compassion.

As we enter the New Year, let us choose to be a parish family that walks with trust, gentleness, and courage. Let us hold one another with care, give thanks for the gifts we have received, and welcome the future God is preparing among us. May our homes and our parish be places where Christ is welcomed, where hope is nurtured, and where love continues to grow.




