### MARYGROVE CAMP

### MISSION CO-OP



On the weekend of **July 18-19**, we will welcome **Father Luis Santi** from the Missionaries of the Precious Blood for the Mission Co-op Appeal. The Missionaries of the Precious Blood was founded in 1815 by St. Gaspar del Bufalo. Today, their missionaries minister in 22 countries and is dedicated to providing retreats, parish ministry, education and health care. The Atlantic Province chapter focuses mainly on Canada but also countries like Tanzania and India. Currently in southern India, they take a special interest in offering education to girls living in poor, remote areas. Their new schools provide these girls with a high school education and a balanced, nourishing meal while at school, helping them learn and improve and providing them with hope for a better future. They have 350 students, all excited to attend. They also run a home for seniors without family to care for them, extending love and dignity to their brothers and sisters through a daily meal and a safe place to live in the last years of their lives. We will hold a second collection for this Mission Co-op on the weekend of **July 25-26**. Please give generously.
