On **July 18-19**, we will welcome **Father Luis Santi** from the Missionaries of the Precious Blood for the Mission Co-op Appeal. The Missionaries of the Precious Blood, founded in 1815 by St. Gaspar del Bufalo, provides retreats, parish ministry, education and health care in 22 countries. The Atlantic Province chapter serves countries like Canada, Tanzania, and India. In southern India, they take a special interest in offering education to girls living in poor, remote areas. Their new schools provide over 350 girls with a high school education and a balanced, nourishing meal while at school, providing them with an opportunity to learn and hope for a better future. Their home for seniors extends love and dignity to their brothers and sisters without family to care for them through a daily meal and a safe place to live in the last years of their lives.
